REMOVAL OF SCANNING AND VERIFICATION CHARGES

In keeping pace with developments and address rising costs in maritime trade, Kenya Ports Authority (KPA) wishes to announce minor Tariff Adjustments. In this connection the following tariff changes will become effective on **1st October 2009**:

Clause 14.10

- Payment for scanning, verification, inspection and associated stripping or stuffing at **US\$.75** and **US\$.110** for 20 foot and 40 foot containers respectively, is **removed**.

Clause 9.2

- Licence fees for private mooring, buoys and jetties is reduced from **US\$.500** to **US\$.200** per annum.

Clause 16.1 & 16.3

- Free period for storage will now be **5** and **11** consecutive days for domestic and transit containerized traffic respectively.

Clause 14.1, 14.2, 14.5 and 14.6

- Shore-handling rates will attract additional US\$.3 and US\$.5 for 20 foot and 40 foot containers respectively. Other Shore-handling rates will be prorated.
