1.	<p>The price schedule forms provided from page 68-72 have a lot of details requested. Kindly confirm these are the forms to be filled or there is another price schedule that can be provided. If not, confirm if all details must be filled or only the final net price can be provided. There is also a column for Quantity offered however there are no quantities indicated in the tender.</p> <p>Please also confirm if it is mandatory to provide a COPP as there is a template provided but no request for the same has been made.</p>	<p>Price schedule forms to be filled as prescribed in the tender document as appropriate.</p> <p>Quantity to be quoted for is one (1). Unit price per drug shall prevail regardless of pack size.</p> <p>Refer to item iv in addendum No. 1</p>
2.	<p>We are requesting clarification regarding the price schedule forms. These forms contain a lot of information some of which is confidential. Secondly there is no quantity in the price schedule, but these forms require us to provide a quantity.</p> <p>Kindly let us know a way forward on how to fill the price schedule or if an alternative price schedule can be provided.</p>	<p>In regard to price schedule format, bidders are hereby informed that this is a new standard tender document approved by Public Procurement Regulatory Authority for use by all Public Institutions. KPA has no right to make any alterations, whatsoever to the standard bidding document. Bidders to comply.</p>
3.	<p>The Price schedule and forms ELI 1.1 are part of the tendering forms under section IV. Section 11/13 for tender pricing states "The Form of Tender and Price Schedules shall be prepared using the relevant forms furnished</p>	<p>Same as 1 and 2 above.</p>

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	<p>in Section IV, Tendering Forms. The forms must be completed without any alterations to the text, and no substitutes shall be accepted except as provided under ITT 20.3. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested"</p> <p>The price schedule has columns 6 to 9 which are not applicable e.g. column 6 mentions quantity offered whereas the list of requirements has no quantities mentioned.</p> <p>Some of the products are missing strengths and the products come in many strengths e.g. the schedule mentions 1026 – rivarox as a product but it comes in 3 different strengths. How are we supposed to quote for all 3 different strengths?</p>	<p>Bidders to quote for all the strengths on the same line provided.</p>
4.	<p>In reference to Section III Evaluation and Qualification Criteria Page 36/37 2.iii all duly completed and signed mandatory tendering forms under section iv: are Tenderers who are distributors importing goods from outside the country required to fill Form ELI-1.1 under section iv (pages 47-48)?</p>	<p>Please refer to addendum No. 1</p>
5.	<p>In reference to Section III Evaluation and Qualification Criteria Page 36/37 2.iv – Registration certificate of premises by Pharmacy and Poisons Board (Certified copy) – Please note PPB no longer certify copies, due to availability of a QR CODE</p>	<p>Certified copies are not necessary anymore with the availability of QR CODE.</p>
6.	<p>On the schedule of supply requirements – Please confirm if more than one brand can be quoted per product code</p>	<p>Single brand to be quoted for.</p>
7.	<p>Kindly confirm contract duration</p>	<p>Three years.</p>

All other conditions remain the same.
